Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain across southern and eastern parts of England and Wales will move slowly northeast through the day, resulting in cool temperatures. Heavy, thundery showers are likely to affect parts of southeast England during the morning, although rain should slowly ease, becoming light and intermittent later. Further north and west scattered showers and sunny spells are expected.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

It will remain unsettled and cooler than of late, with further showers or longer spells of rain through both days, although some drier and brighter interludes are likely too. It will turn windy at times in the south and west.
