

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Friday 05 Dec 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers across Wales, western and southern England gradually becoming confined to the southwest of England. Meanwhile outbreaks of rain and sleet, with snow on hills, will move across northeastern parts of the UK. Elsewhere mainly dry, with patchy fog clearing today. Gales across the extreme southwest initially. Overnight most places becoming dry, with pockets of fog and frost forming.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday showers for the Northern Isles, and isolated light showers across the far southwest of England and some eastern English coasts. Otherwise dry and sunny, patchy fog mostly clearing. Sunday rain reaching northwest Scotland, elsewhere dry and sunny, fog clearing.
