Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain soon clearing the east. Otherwise, sunny spells and scattered showers, most frequent and heavy near southern and western coasts with a risk of hail and thunder. Showers perhaps wintry over northwestern hills. Overnight, showers will continue in the north and west and along English Channel coasts. Drier further east and inland with a patchy frost.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Fairly unsettled throughout, with bright or sunny spells and scattered showers on both Friday and Saturday. Still the risk of hail and thunder at times. Feeling rather cold with brisk winds. The best of any drier weather will tend to be in the east.
