

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 04 Dec 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Heavy rain, with heavy snow from the Midlands and mid Wales, northwards, will move east, mostly clearing from eastern England by lunchtime, though lingering into the afternoon over northeast England and persisting overnight across northeast Scotland. Significant snow accumulations over northern high ground with strong southerly winds giving blizzard conditions. Heavy, blustery showers following from the west.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Sleet, hill snow, over northeast Scotland clearing by Friday night then a few showers. Mostly dry over eastern England. Frequent heavy showers and very windy over southern and western Britain during Friday. Mostly dry on Saturday with long sunny periods and light winds.
