Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It'll be a warm and dry for most, with sunny spells and variable cloud amounts. However northern parts and the far west will be cooler as thicker cloud gradually spreads in, bringing sporadic outbreaks of rain. This cloud and rain will continue eastwards overnight, although some far eastern parts could stay dry.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

It will be a fairly grey and cloudy start to the week, with outbreaks of rain continuing to spread eastwards across the UK on Monday. Although it could turn drier and brighter in the west later. Tuesday then remains unsettled, with a mixture of sunny spells and showers.
