Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A chilly start in the southeast with fog slowly clearing through the morning. It will then be dry and mild for most, with plenty of sunny spells for all except western Scotland and the far west of England and Wales.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Thursday will start dry and bright in the southeast, while in the northwest it will be a wet and windy. This band of cloud and rain will move southeast reaching central parts by dusk, and all except the far southeast by nightfall. On Friday, the rain will continue to move southeastwards, clearing western parts later in the afternoon.
