Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Many parts will be dry and fine with spells of sunshine, although high cloud will tend to make the sunshine rather hazy. However, thicker cloud will spread patchy rain into parts of Northern Ireland during the afternoon, perhaps reaching western districts of Scotland towards evening. In the sunshine it should feel pleasantly warm.

Most places remaining dry and bright this evening but outbreaks of rain spreading across many northern and some central areas overnight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

On Thursday, mainly dry and bright in the south but cloudy with rain at times elsewhere. Most places dry on Friday with some warm sunshine developing.
