Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:

It will gradually brighten up across Scotland and Northern Ireland through the day but turn quite breezy, with winds becoming southerly. Elsewhere, it will be dry with some sunshine, after mist and fog slowly clears, and temperatures will climb back into double figures. It will become cloudy across southern England by evening though, with a few spots of drizzle possible.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Wet and windy conditions will move eastwards across the UK over the weekend, gradually introducing colder, more unsettled weather. Scattered sleet and snow showers are expected to follow spells of more persistent rain and overnight frosts are likely to return.
