

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 18 Feb 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A rather cloudy day with light rain in places, particularly in parts of  
Scotland, where it may be heavier at times. Some brighter spells should develop  
further south. By evening, persistent rain will spread eastwards, turning to  
snow on hills from the Pennines northwards after midnight. Feeling cold in  
southeasterly winds. Drier conditions will move into southwestern areas by dawn.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

On Saturday rain across the north and east, with snow on hills, will mostly  
clear by evening. Drier conditions, with some bright spells and occasional  
showers, will follow from the west, continuing into Sunday. It will be windy at  
times.
