

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally rather cloudy with a few scattered showers, these most persistent over northern Scotland, and falling as snow over Shetland at first. Bright spells at times elsewhere, but chilly in the east. Quickly turning cold this evening in southern England under clearing skies. However, temperatures recovering later as thickening cloud and patchy rain spreads south overnight.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Patchy rain in eastern areas clearing during Sunday morning, as brighter conditions elsewhere spread east. Rain reaching northwestern UK during the afternoon and spreading southeast overnight. Monday will be wet and windy in the south with sunshine and showers elsewhere, some of these heavy.
