Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
It's another icy start in places, with a sunny day for most. There will still be a few showers in the east, but mainly falling as rain today. Across Northern Ireland and Scotland, skies will turn cloudier with perhaps a little snow, but this will soon turn to rain. Overnight it will be less cold than recent nights.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
The cloud will spread into the rest of the UK over the weekend. The odd bright spell is possible, but there will be a few outbreaks of light rain or drizzle where cloud is thick enough, and it will still feel chilly.
