

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 1945 on Saturday 24 Nov 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Dry to start with in many places on Sunday, with some brightness. It will become increasingly cloudy from the northwest though with a few showery outbreaks here later, particularly over western Scotland. It should stay dry in the southeast until evening with the best of any brightness here, though it may turn quite chilly here in the evening.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rather cloudy on Monday with some rain at times, mainly in the east & north of Britain. On Tuesday the damp weather should be confined to the north of the country with drier conditions reserved for the south. It should be largely frost-free.
