Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
There is a risk of some rain clipping the far southeast of England at first, but this should clear by lunchtime. Elsewhere: still breezy with sunshine and a scattering of showers for most, but both the showers and winds should be lighter than on Thursday with much more in the way of drier, brighter intervals.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:
There'll still be a few showers on Saturday after a chilly start but many places will be dry and bright. Rain spreads to the north & west on Sunday, with some very strong winds again, reaching the south on Monday with showers following to the north.
