Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a bright start for many, it will turn increasingly cloudy from the west with some patchy rain arriving later, though this will turn heavier and more persistent over Scotland and Northern Ireland for a time. Eastern parts will probably stay mostly dry, and fairly warm though daylight hours.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Northwestern parts of the UK will see some rain on Saturday, locally heavy, while the south and east stay largely dry, fine and warm with temperatures perhaps into the low 20's in places. On Sunday the rain will spread southeast to affect most parts, with heavy showers following to the west.
