Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain in East Anglia and the far southeast will clear through the day. Elsewhere, sunshine and showers, especially in the west where they could turn thundery. Brightest across central parts. Feeling rather cold. Tonight showers will continue near western coasts, but becoming dry inland with a widespread frost, some mist and fog patches.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Many places dry and bright on Sunday with sunny spells after a frosty start, but showers in the far north and west which will tend to fade later. Monday will start bright and chilly for most, then becoming wet and windy from the west.
