

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 17 Mar 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain and strong winds will affect northwestern Scotland, with some heavy rain at times. It will be mostly dry and cloudy elsewhere, apart from a little drizzle in the west, but sunshine should develop in central and eastern England. Rain will become more widespread across Scotland, Northern Ireland and northern England overnight, and winds will strengthen too.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Outbreaks of rain, some heavy and thundery, will affect many places on Tuesday, especially the northern half of the UK. Rain will continue across northwestern Britain on Wednesday but it should be mostly dry and bright elsewhere. Winds will remain quite strong throughout.
