Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Fog inland will gradually clear but may persist around some coasts. It will then be a rather cloudy day with showers will break out during the morning, which could become heavy in the west. Heavy rain will spread into southeast England this evening, moving northwards across the east, Northern England and Scotland overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Heavy rain will clear northern England during the afternoon and Scotland during the evening. Elsewhere there will be sunny intervals with just a few showers. Most parts will be dry on Wednesday with some sunshine, although a little rain is expected in the west.
