Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain in central Britain will return towards western areas, tending to becoming more showery does so. The brightest weather will be in the east this afternoon. It will feel generally warm in light winds, but still rather chilly near some eastern coasts.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Mostly dry on Tuesday and Wednesday with some long sunny spells in most areas, although the outside chance of a shower developing locally in the west. Temperatures are expected to steadily rise in most parts, becoming generally warm, but staying on the cool side along some east coasts.
