

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 07 Feb 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A bright start for many, but rain, sleet and snow will spread east into western parts of the UK, with the snow largely confined to hills. Further east, it should stay drier with hazy sunshine, but snow showers may continue along East Anglian coasts. Overnight rain, sleet and snow should become lighter and more patchy as it moves slowly eastwards.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Often cloudy on Friday and Saturday, with outbreaks of light rain, sleet and snow at times. The snow will remain largely over hills. There should also be some bright spells, with the best of these in the southeast on Friday.
