

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Wednesday 02 Sep 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain spreads northeastwards across England and Wales today. Rain will be light at first but becomes heavy and persistent. The rain clears all but the northeast and overnight, to be replaced by showers, some of which will be heavy. Elsewhere, showers will affect Scotland and Northern Ireland, these becoming widespread during the day.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Wind and rain linger in the northeast but elsewhere there will be a mix of sunshine and showers. Rain edges into the south later on Thursday, continuing into Friday morning. On Friday rain clears the northeast and most places have a mix of sunshine and showers.
