

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry with plenty of sunshine. It'll turn increasingly warm and humid later, or hot towards the southeast. Cloud will gradually build from the southwest, with isolated showers possible late in the day. Heavy rain and thunderstorms will soon move northeastwards overnight, with some torrential downpours, before drier conditions follow. Patchy low cloud and fog will affect some eastern coasts.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Breezy and cooler across Scotland, with heavy rain gradually easing and clearing north. Largely dry elsewhere on Saturday with warm sunny spells developing. Very warm again in the southeast. Increasingly breezy on Sunday, with scattered showers and some warm sunny spells.
