Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Much of England and Wales will have outbreaks of rain at first, this heavy in parts of the Southeast. Scotland and Northern Ireland should see sunny spells and showers, whilst the rain becomes confined to eastern England through the day. It'll be a dry and cloudy night for most, but occasional rain may affect parts of southern England and Wales.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Cloudy with rain or showers on Tuesday, this becoming heavy across Northern Ireland during the afternoon. Sunny spells and showers for many on Wednesday, these turning heavy and thundery across western England and Wales, as outbreaks of rain affect Scotland.
