

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 05 Apr 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A bright start over northeastern Britain but patchy rain spreading here through the day. Dry and bright in much of southeastern England, but becoming increasingly cloudy. Outbreaks of rain elsewhere, heavy over high ground in northwest. Mild and breezy night, with rain or drizzle in the west. More organised and persistent rain, heavy at times, reaching western parts towards dawn.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Windy Sunday, with the rain band spreading northeastwards while weakening in south. Heaviest rain in northwest. Clearer, cooler with scattered showers reaching western areas through the evening. Rain Monday, heavy at times, windy in south. Clearer conditions spreading east later.
