

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, with some snow on northern hills, eventually clearing the extreme east later today. Sunny spells and scattered showers elsewhere, the showers heavy at times, and becoming more frequent later in the northwest. Becoming dry for a time for much of the UK tonight, but heavy, showery rain will spread across northern and western areas through the early hours.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Heavy showery rain, with hill snow, will move eastwards across the UK through the morning. Scattered showers will then follow into the north and west, but otherwise it will be largely dry and bright. Becoming wet and windy on Friday.
