Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
There will be clear blue skies for many today, but it will be staying chilly. A few showers are likely in coastal areas, but these will gradually begin to ease. Temperatures will drop quickly in the evening, but many places will be staying dry.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Monday will be off to a cold and frosty start for most. The weather will stay dry, bright and chilly in the southeast, but in the northwest it will turn increasingly cloudy, wet, and windy with heavy rain and a risk of gales. Tuesday is likely to stay unsettled with more wet and windy conditions likely.
