Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Mist and fog may well be slow to clear in the southwest through tomorrow morning. Otherwise, cloud and patchy drizzle in the south will gradually thin, leaving a largely dry day across the bulk of the UK with some bright spells. However, a band of rain will reach the northwest later.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Turning colder over the weekend, with rain clearing to scattered showers on Saturday. Showers will continue at first on Sunday, especially in the west, but the showers will gradually ease thereafter, leaving a largely dry and bright afternoon. Clear skies overnight will lead to a widespread frost though.
