Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain across Scotland will turn more showery, then northern areas will have sunny intervals and blustery showers, though these should die out later. Rain across southeast England will clear this morning, then southern areas will be mostly dry with sunny periods. A windy day, gales for some northern areas. but easing later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday, mostly cloudy and windy with rain or drizzle, this mainly in the west, here turning misty over hills. Central and eastern parts of England drier and brighter, and becoming locally warm. Good Friday, cloudy with organised rain edging eastwards, some becoming heavy and prolonged.
