General Situation

Pressure will remain high over the north, maintaining settled weather here.
However in south thundery troughs and lows are expected during the next couple of days.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney

24 hour forecast:

Variable 2 to 4, becoming east or southeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4, backing northeast 3 to 5 later.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 to 5 increasing 5 or 6, decreasing 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate becoming moderate.

Rain later.

Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or northeast becoming cyclonic, 4 or 5, then northwest 2 to 4 later.

Moderate becoming slight.

Rain or showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Moderate becoming slight or moderate.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery in south.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic becoming southwesterly, 3 to 5.

Slight or moderate, occasionally smooth later in the wash and Thames estuary.

Rain or thundery showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeasterly 5 or 6, becoming cyclonic 3 or 4, then southwesterly 4 to 6 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time in west.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in east, backing southerly 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, rain later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:

East 3 to 5, becoming variable 2 to 4, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5 backing southeast 3 or 4, veering south 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Showers, occasional rain or thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly

24 hour forecast:

East or southeast 3 to 5, becoming variable 4 or less, then southwest 4 or 5 later.

Slight or moderate, becoming smooth or slight for a time.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest 4 or 5 backing south or southeast 3 or 4, becoming cyclonic 3 to 5 later.

Slight or moderate.

Showers, occasional rain or thundery showers later.

Good, occasionally poor later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

24 hour forecast:

East or northeast 3 or 4 becoming cyclonic 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, but moderate at first in west and later in far southwest.

Rain or showers, perhaps thundery.

Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Cyclonic 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming southwest 3 or 4 for a time.

Smooth or slight, but moderate in southwest.
Rain or thundery showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 to 5, becoming cyclonic later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in west.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Cyclonic 3 to 5 becoming variable 3 or less.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first in northwest.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway
24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 to 5.
Smooth or slight.
Rain or showers later.
Good, occasionally moderate later.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
East or northeast 4 or 5 decreasing 2 to 4 later.
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in northwest, becoming smooth later.
Rain or showers.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Isle of Man

Easterly or northeasterly 3 to 5, becoming variable 4 or less.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in North Channel.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point

24 hour forecast:

North 2 to 4 veering east 3 to 5, backing northeast 3 or 4 later.

Smooth or slight.

Fair.

Good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Northeast 3 or 4 veering east 3 to 5, becoming variable 4 or less.

Smooth or slight.

Mainly fair.

Good.

The Minch

24 hour forecast:

North veering northeast, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.

Smooth or slight.

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Ridge of high pressure gradually extending from the south.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Nil

Westerly 2 to 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or less later

Slight occasionally moderate in north, but smooth in lee shelter

Mainly fair

Mainly good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 0600 UTC on Sunday 05 Jun until 1800 UTC on Sunday 05

Jun:

Variable 3 or less

Slight occasionally moderate at first in far north, but smooth in lee shelter

Mainly fair

Mainly good

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Easterly 3 to 5, perhaps occasionally 6 mid-channel at first, locally variable 1 to 3, becoming west to southwest by dawn.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate in the north at first and again later.

Showers, locally heavy with a risk of thunder, mostly clearing during the morning mist and a risk of fog patches clearing during the morning.

Good, occasionally moderate to poor, perhaps very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South to southwest 3 to 5.

Smooth or slight, locally moderate in the northwest.

Rain and drizzle, locally heavy, with mist and risk of fog after dawn.

Good, becoming moderate to poor, perhaps locally very poor.

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
