Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be brighter with scattered showers across northern and central areas, some wintry. Staying mostly dry in the west. Light rain or sleet is expected in southeastern and some southern areas with snow possible over hills. It will feel cold in the south and east as the northeast wind freshens.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Continuing mainly dry with bright or sunny spells in the west with a few wintry showers later. Generally cloudier with sleet or snow showers in the east and some significant snow accumulations are possible on Wednesday. Widespread overnight frosts developing and feeling cold in northeasterly winds.
