Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Many western and southern areas will be grey and damp with patchy light rain or drizzle, and with fog over the hills. Eastern areas will be generally dry with bright or sunny spells, and some brighter spells may also develop in parts of the west and south.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

It should remain dry in many areas, but with rather a lot of cloud for many. However, some bright or sunny intervals are likely in places, and it will be fairly warm inland in the afternoons. However, during Friday, rain will spread southwards across northern areas, with clearer, colder weather to follow.
