Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a frosty start, it will be a very cold and largely sunny day across the UK, with light snow showers in eastern England, giving a covering in places. However it will be rather cloudy across the far northwest with some patchy rain. Overnight will see a widespread frost return with further snow showers developing across East Anglia and Kent.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Remaining mainly fine and very cold on Friday with the chance of snow showers in the southeast. Turning unsettled and perhaps less cold on Saturday, with rain preceded by snow spreading from the northwest and strong winds in the north.
