Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Patchy fog may linger all day in a few places, particularly across southwest England. Otherwise, much of the country should have a dry day with brighter spells at times, despite a good deal of cloud. However, rain will spread quickly to Northern Ireland and parts of western Scotland this afternoon. It will feel rather chilly in many places, although it will be less cold than recently.

Rain will spread to most other parts overnight. Becoming misty, with hill fog, but also much milder.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Most parts overcast on Monday with rain at times. Drier and brighter on Tuesday but locally windy.
