Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Many parts will be largely dry, with the best of the sunshine across central and southeastern areas, where it will also feel pleasantly warm. It will remain wet across northwestern Scotland, however, and gales are likely to affect the north.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

During Thursday a band of occasionally heavy rain will gradually move southwards, but the far southeast should remain dry until evening. Turning colder on Friday, with sunny spells and scattered showers, after any lingering rain in the far southeast clears. Showers sometimes heavy and wintry, mainly in the north and west. Windy on both days, with gales in the northwest.
