

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Eastern and northern England will see a cloudy day, with patchy rain gradually easing away. The Northern Isles will catch a few showers, but most other areas will see some sunshine, and whilst pleasantly warm in the south, it will feel cool in the north. Overnight, it will be dry with clear spells, and chilly again in the north.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Much of the UK will be fine and dry on Monday and Tuesday, with temperatures on the rise once again. However, the northwest will see an increasing southwesterly breeze, introducing thicker cloud and outbreaks of rain, particularly across western Scotland.
