

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Southeastern parts of England and Wales will be cloudy, cold with patchy rain and a northeasterly wind, slowly clearing from the northwest. Elsewhere, largely dry and sunny after a frosty start. Isolated wintry showers in the far north. Widespread frost overnight across central areas with some freezing fog patches. Increasingly cloudy and breezy in the far north with patchy frost.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Mainly dry with light winds and sunny spells for most Wednesday. However, the far northwest and southeast are likely to be cloudier, breezier with scattered showers. Starting mostly dry Thursday, with local frost and fog patches. Rain moving southeastwards later.
