

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 03 Nov 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Sunny spells are expected over N.Ireland and Scotland, once any early fog clears, and also in other sheltered western areas. Otherwise generally cloudy but dry. Feeling chilly in the southeast, with some light rain there this afternoon. That light rain will spread across much of England and Wales overnight. Mainly dry elsewhere with clear spells and some fog.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Largely cloudy over England and Wales with some outbreaks of light rain around, especially in the north on Tuesday and more widely on Wednesday. Generally dry over N.Ireland and Scotland with some sunny spells, but some rain is likely later on Wednesday.
