Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Squally rain with severe gales in the Northern Isles clearing this morning. Rain in Wales and southern England, heavy in west, moving quickly north across all parts, accompanied by strong winds. Brighter in Northern Ireland and the southeast of England in afternoon. Rain becoming confined to Shetland and the far south of England as blustery showers develop in northwest Scotland overnight.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Outbreaks of rain in far south of England from time to time. Heavy, blustery showers in Scotland, crossing Wales and England on Friday. Sunny spells elsewhere, a few showers in the west. Feeling colder, occasionally severe gales in Scotland.
