Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
After a chilly start, Friday will be a dry and sunny day for many. However, showers will affect eastern coasts, and also Pembrokeshire and Cornwall, while outbreaks of rain will reach Northern Ireland during the evening. Fresh winds easing throughout the day, making it feel less cold than Thursday.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It'll be cold on Saturday, with outbreaks of rain and hill snow sporadically pushing across the UK, and with drier and clearer conditions spreading into Northern Ireland late in the day. It will be drier and much brighter on Sunday, but also with a few wintry showers, mainly in the east.
