

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
N.Ireland, northern England and much of Scotland will see blustery showers today, with wintry falls inland. Otherwise, plenty of sunshine is expected, with early rain soon clearing southeast England. Feeling cold. Largely dry, clear and chilly overnight with some ground frost, but becoming cloudy and windy with rain over western Scotland, and some snow initially.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Largely dry and mild, but rather breezy on both Friday and Saturday with plenty of cloud, especially on Saturday. However, cloudy, wet and windy weather is expected across Scotland, and parts of N.Ireland and northern England on Friday, although this will clear northeastwards during Saturday.
