

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Monday 18 Nov 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Outbreaks of rain will push southeastwards through the day. Much colder, brighter and showery weather will follow, with showers falling as snow over the hills in northwestern Britain. Wintry showers will spread south, down the western side of the UK overnight, with some accumulations of snow possible, mainly over the hills. Elsewhere, it will be clear with a frost developing.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

It will be cold on Tuesday with sunshine and scattered wintry showers. A frost will return for many overnight. It then looks set to turn unsettled from the north through Wednesday with gales, rain and hill snow for a time.
