Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Chilly at first, with early mist and fog patches clearing to bring a  
bright or sunny day. Cloud and patchy light rain will spread into  
some western parts. Heavier rain may reach Northern Ireland later.  
Overnight, cloud and rain in the northwest will edge east across many  
northern and western parts. Other areas will stay dry, mist patches  
forming in the southeast where skies stay clear. Temperatures will  
rise to near or a little above normal.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Cloud and showery rain moving southeast, sunny periods and heavy  
showers following from the northwest on Thursday. Rain returning to  
northwestern parts on Friday.
