

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sunny spells and showers, especially in the west and extreme south, some heavy with hail or thunder. Northern England and southern Scotland seeing more frequent showers and hill snow at times. Much of eastern and central England dry and fine. Overnight, many places dry and cold with a frost, but cloud and rain spreading across southern Britain by morning.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

On Sunday, southern England seeing fairly persistent and locally heavy rain, this clearing slowly eastward. Elsewhere, largely dry with sunny spells and a few showers. On Monday, further showers for many, these tending to die out towards evening. Feeling rather cold.
