

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 15 Jul 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Rain in the north-west will be moving southeastwards through the day and will become increasingly light reaching southern Wales and central England by evening. Sunshine and showers will follow into northern areas. It will be a largely dry day across more southern counties albeit rather cloudy, although some warm sunny spells at times.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Many areas will see some dry and bright conditions with sunny spells for a time on Wednesday. However, cloud is expected to increase with showers or light rain later, moderate in the north. Some bright spells around on Thursday but also showers or light rain at times.
