Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scotland and Northern Ireland will be mostly dry with some sunshine today and clear spells overnight. England and Wales will be cloudier with rain or showers, perhaps occasionally heavy through the afternoon across southern England, where it'll feel warmer today. Brisk Easterly winds for most parts.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain across Wales and southern and central England will tend to become confined to southwestern England through Monday. Dry with sunny spells elsewhere. Temperatures around the average for late April. Generally cloudy through Tuesday, with some rain in places, but with some sunshine too.
