Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Northwestern Scotland and western Northern Ireland will be cloudy this morning. Elsewhere, another mainly dry and mostly sunny day after cloud in central and eastern England this morning breaks up. After a chilly start, it will become pleasantly warm. Overnight, cloud will spread back across England and Wales, with some isolated heavy showers developing over East Anglia by morning.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Mainly dry with sunny spells in northern Britain, although isolated showers are likely over Scotland on Friday. Heavy and thundery showers over southern Britain on Friday, becoming confined to the far south on Saturday. Feeling chilly in a strengthening easterly wind.
