Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Rain in central and eastern areas moving eastwards, clearing  
southeast England by early afternoon. Brighter weather following with  
squally showers, especially in western areas. Some will be heavy with  
thunder. Eastern areas should see the best of the brighter conditions  
but even here some showers are likely, blown in on strong to gale  
force winds which will also make it feel cold.

Showers continuing in western and southern parts while many eastern  
areas become dry. Winds locally reaching gale or severe gale force.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Windy with showers on Monday. Rain in northern parts on Tuesday but  
dry across England and Wales.
