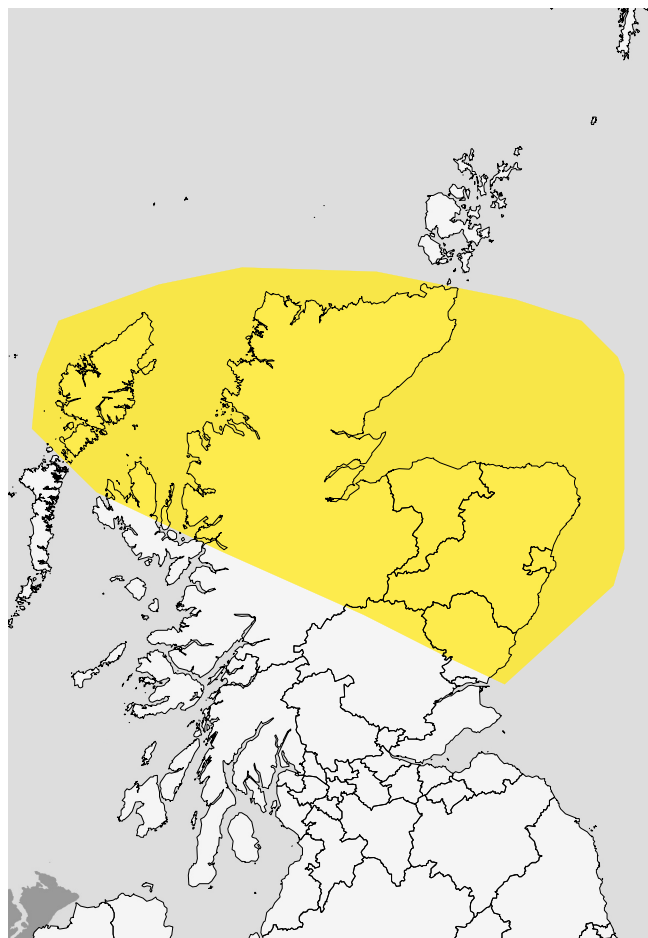

- Some roads and railways likely to be affected with longer journey times by road, bus and train services

Further details

An area of rain, sleet and snow, accompanied by gusty winds will continue slowly eastwards across northern Scotland Sunday afternoon and evening. Where snow falls, 1 to 3 cm are likely whilst on ground above 200 metres 2 to 5 cm is likely and above 400 metres, accumulations will be higher and close to 5 to 10 cm in some places.
