Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Most places will be dry with sunny spells after a rather cloudy start across southern England, and any light showers across East Anglia and southeast England should die out. Northern Ireland, however, may remain generally cloudy. It will feel quite warm in sunshine and light winds, though northerly breezes will keep areas near the North Sea rather chilly.

Tonight, most places will stay dry with clear spells, and locally a touch of frost and patchy mist. A little rain may spread to parts of eastern England.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Becoming unsettled and windy with outbreaks of rain or showers, some of these heavy and prolonged. It will also feel cooler.
