Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Showers or longer spells of rain will affect northwestern areas, especially western Scotland where some heavy rain is likely, and northwest England. A few showers will also affect other western areas at times whereas most central and eastern areas should be dry and bright, southeastern areas seeing the best of the available sunshine. Relatively mild in the sunshine, but feeling colder in the cloud, rain and strengthening winds further north where gales are expected later.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Wet, windy weather moving southeast across all parts on Tuesday, followed by brighter, colder conditions. Extremely windy on Wednesday with severe gales and some rain.
