
Daily Air Quality Index – Saturday 02/01/2021





Air Quality Forecast for the UK

Issued by the Met Office

Today: Low cloud and freezing fog in the south, will be slow to clear, ahead of cloud and patchy rain moving southwards across England and Wales. Otherwise, sunshine and showers in the north and east. Air pollution levels will be Low across the UK today.

Tomorrow: Largely dry with sunny spells for many. Some showers affecting coastal regions, where possibly wintry, especially as they move inland. Staying cold. Air pollution levels will remain Low during Saturday.

Outlook: The cold weather pattern will continue during this period, with wintry showers affecting eastern and southeastern parts, where windier. Drier elsewhere. Air pollution levels are expected to remain Low throughout.
